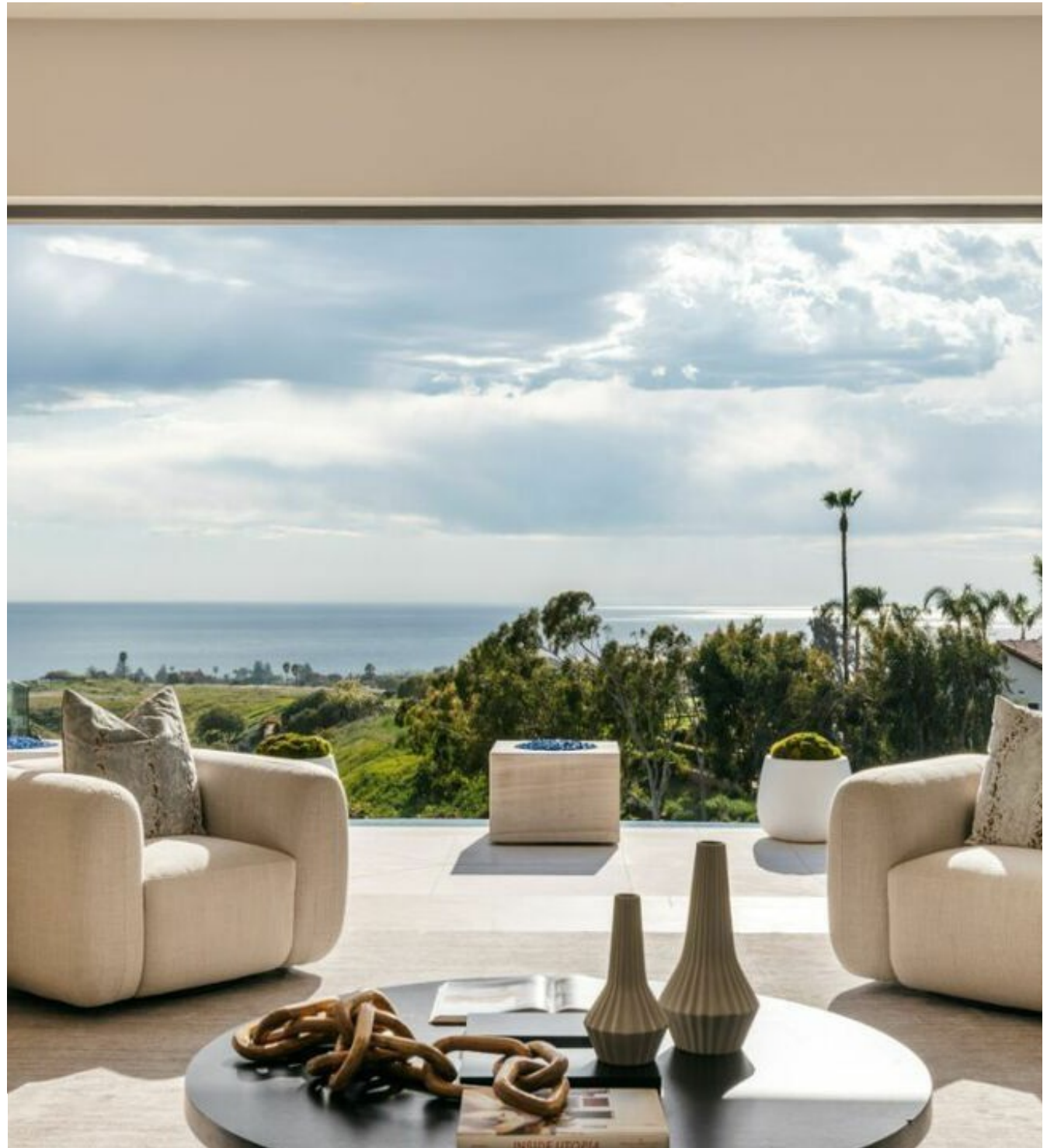

To the west of the foyer, the expansive primary suite includes a large bedroom w/ sitting area, dual bathrooms, a customizable walk-in closet, a bar & floor-to-ceiling accordion glass sliders that fully open to an expansive deck with a fire pit & breathtaking ocean & neighborhood views. To the east of the foyer, there is an elevated lounge, three additional en-suite bedrooms, and an office w/ ocean view decks. A staircase or the elevator takes the guest down to the spacious gym that features a luxurious spa that includes a walk-in steam shower, dry sauna, bathroom, and direct access to the backyard. The exterior of the property is just as impressive as the interior & features an infinity edge pool w/ spa, multiple fire pits, seating areas & a wrap-around grass yard w/ rose garden. The property also features a double-gated driveway, a 3-car garage, and an attached in-law suite.
